

INTERACTING WITH MARINE WILDLIFE RESPONSIBLY



Be non-intrusive, do not tease or provoke them.



Approach and watch them from their sides.



Do not make any noise while in the water.



Do not block or capture them.



Watch them eat naturally. Do not feed them.



Monopods should not be used.



Enjoy looking at them, but never touch them.



Do not use flash and other artificial lights.



Use marine-life friendly sunscreen, applied in advance.



Underwater motorized propulsion devices are not allowed.



Use mooring buoys, no dropping of anchor.



Non-regulated motorized and hard to maneuver vessels are not allowed.
